	plans as the cost of the whole development was too high, the option

	pitches. Currently the FA have a partnership with Howdens	
	kitchens who would also provide a new Kitchen. The plan would	
	then allow us to hold functions in the facilities.	
	The current drainage system will need to be upgraded as currently	
	not fit for purpose, this will be looked in to by the Clerk. The Clerk	
	will request final plans from the architects and will then send out to tender.
