- 4. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday, 1st November 2023. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate can be made online: www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-to-vote
- 5. New applications to vote by proxy at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Pathfinder House, St Mary's Street, Huntingdon, PE29 3TN by 5 pm on Wednesday, 1st November 2023.
- 6. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Pathfinder House, St Mary's Street, Huntingdon, PE29 3TN by 5 pm on Thursday, 9th November 2023. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 1st November 2023. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 1st November 2023.
