The tender’s applications will be emailed to the Clerk who can’t open them until after 12pm on 29<sup>th</sup> September and then he will forward them on to HSSP for them to go through the applications.</p> <p><b>5.2</b> Booking system with scribe – Update from the Clerk – Previous teething issues have now been corrected, the system is working well and generates invoices and receipts, Only the Parish office will have access to the booking system.</p> <p><b>5.3</b> The Fishing Lake – Lease agreement – Circulated, the draft version we currently hold will need some slight amendments, any items to be added the Committee will email the Clerk by next Friday 29<sup>th</sup> September.</p> <p><b>5.4</b> Rabbits / Fencing – Recently the problem is getting worse, the Clerk will look into obtaining some quotations.</p> <p><b>5.5</b> Alcohol License – The Sports Club will apply for a Club Licence – Approved Cllr Tuplin Seconded by Cllr Gadsby and all in favour.</p> <p><b>5.6</b> Pitch Grant with the FA – Current project is for 6 years to improve the quality of the pitches; this item also links in to 5.4 the fences as the rabbits are causing damage to the pitch.</p> <p><b>5.7</b> Fireworks – The Parish Council will fund the fireworks again this year, Ticket prices will be £5 on the Night or £4 in advance for School age group Year 7 and over, School age group year 6 and under will Free – proposed by Cllr Tuplin and seconded by Cllr Gadsby and all in favour.</p>	Town and Country Planning Act 1990
